## INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS

*Prior to submitting their work, authors should check the updated information at the Internet site <http://pefmath.etf.bg.ac.yu> (referred to as "the Web site" in the sequel). All changes of email addresses or other relevant data after the publication of this issue, will be posted there.*

**How to prepare articles:** The articles should be written in English language. The style of writing must meet usual standards for mathematical papers. Papers written in a careless manner will not be accepted, independently of their mathematical contents.

Authors are requested to use LaTeX or TeX in preparation of their articles, preferably in a LaTeX template that can be downloaded from the Web site. The template contains also specific style guidelines. Exceptionally, Word files will also be accepted. The specific guidelines regarding the style can be downloaded at the Web site.

**How to send:** Authors should send their contributions to the editor in chief ([emerkle@etf.bg.ac.yu](mailto:emerkle@etf.bg.ac.yu)), the associate editor ([cakic@etf.bg.ac.yu](mailto:cakic@etf.bg.ac.yu)), or to any editor (i.e., to any member of the Editorial Board) via email, by submitting files of their work as attachments, accompanied with a filled out copy of the submission form. Only .pdf (or, exceptionally, Word) files should be sent as submissions. Email addresses of editors can be found in the Web site, together with other updated information.

**Submission form:** The submission form (a Word file) can be downloaded from the Web site. Each submission is to be accompanied with a filled out copy of the submission form. In addition to author(s) name(s) and email address(es), the fields in the submission form that are required to fill out include 2000 MSC classification, key words and phrases, and names and email addresses of four mathematicians that could be asked to referee the submitted paper. The proposed referees should not be editors, nor the members of the advisory board of this journal. Submissions received without a submission form will not be processed.

**Correspondence with author(s):** The editors and the editorial staff communicate with authors solely by email. If the article is written by more than one author, the emails from editors will be directed to the corresponding author, as indicated in the submission form.

**Acceptance and publishing:** Upon the acceptance, the corresponding author will be asked to supply a TeX file, for the final preparation of the paper. The acceptance letter will be sent to corresponding author by email. Exceptionally, upon request, a letter of acceptance may be sent to a postal address.
